TEEMA 1: Introduction to the United Nations (UN) and MUN	
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused
 Students will understand the structure and functions of the United Nations (UN). Students will be familiar with the purpose and goals of MUN. Students will grasp the significance of global governance and diplomacy. 	 Overview of the UN: history, main bodies (e.g. General Assembly, Security Council), and key functions. Introduction to MUN: history, purpose, and general rules of procedure. Interactive lectures and group discussions on the roles of different UN bodies and their relevance in global issues, and the importance of international cooperation. Watching video clips of the UN sessions and on the UN's role in peacekeeping or humanitarian efforts.

TEEMA 2: Research and Position Papers	
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused



- Students will learn how to conduct research on international issues.
- Students will be able to write position papers representing a country's stance on various topics.
- Students will develop skills in sourcing credible information and forming evidence-based arguments.

- Research skills and the use of databases, academic journals, and credible sources.
- Demonstration of conducting research on global issues and preparing country profiles.
- Students present a country profile based on a given topic.
- Position papers and their role in MUN.
- Step-by-step guide to writing a position paper, including format and structure.
- Students select a country and issue to research and practice writing a position paper.
- Peer review of country profile presentations and position papers.

Ainevaldkondade ülene lõiming (kui on):

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- Research (Uurimistöö): Skills in researching, evaluating, and citing sources.
- English: Formal and academic reading, writing and public speaking.

Õpitulemus Students will gain confidence in public speaking and presenting arguments. Students will understand the principles of diplomacy and how to negotiate effectively. Students will learn how to communicate persuasively while respecting different viewpoints. Public speaking and Diplomacy Public speaking workshops focusing on clarity, tone, and body language. Role-playing exercises where students practice delivering speeches in a formal setting. Diplomatic language, negotiation tactics, and maintaining professionalism. Practice sessions where students present their positions on issues and receive feedback. Simulation of a UN committee session to practice real-time negotiation and debate.

TEEMA 4: Resolution Writing and Amendments		
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused	
 Students will be able to draft formal resolutions that address global issues. Students will learn how to propose and debate amendments to resolutions. Students will understand the process of reaching consensus on complex issues. 	 Workshop on writing resolutions, including preambulatory and operative clauses. Exercises on proposing, debating, and voting on amendments. Group work where students draft resolutions on assigned topics. Mock sessions where resolutions are debated, amended, and voted on. 	
TEEMA 5: Debate and Negotiation Strategies		
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused	
 Students will develop advanced debating skills, including rebuttal and cross-examination. Students will learn strategies for negotiating agreements in a multilateral setting. 	 Advanced debate techniques and strategies for effective argumentation. Negotiation tactics, including finding common ground and compromising. Case studies of successful and failed negotiations in international relations. Debate simulations where students defend their country's position on various issues. 	



TEEMA 6: MUN Conference Preparation and Organization	
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused
 Students will be fully prepared to participate in an MUN conference (MUNOT, ESTMUN, mobilities abroad). Students will learn how to organize and manage an MUN event. Students will develop leadership and teamwork skills. 	 Overview of the logistics involved in organizing an MUN conference. Assigning roles and responsibilities for conference preparation. Planning and conducting practice sessions for the upcoming MUN conference. Setting up committees, preparing agendas, and organizing materials. Post-conference reflection and feedback session to discuss learning outcomes.
TEEMA: Õppekäigud	
Õpitulemus	Õppesisu- ja tegevused
 Students will gain practical insights into governmental and non-governmental institutions, international organizations and diplomacy. Students will experience real-world applications of course objectives. Students will build connections with professionals in the field of international relations and expand their network. 	 Visit to MONDO – Maailmakool to learn about global issues, global education and development projects. Visit to Europa Elamuskeskus to explore the European Union (EU), watch a movie about the EU history and parliamentary democracy, and play their engaging Role Play Game on how decisions are made in the EU. Riigikogu tour for a firsthand look at national governance. Participation in RaRa educational programs focused on research, media literacy and the EU. MUN conference attendance (MUNOT, ESTMUN and other opportunities abroad via Erasmus+)
